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**LUGUBRIOUS** (*adjective*) very sad or mournful, often to an exaggerated extent

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**HAGGARD** (*adjective*) appearing worn and exhausted

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**CLANDESTINE** (*adjective*) secret or hidden

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**VIVACIOUS** (*adjective*) lively and bright; animated; full of spirit

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**OPULENT** (*adjective*) very wealthy; luxurious

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**AUSPICIOUS** (*adjective*) promising success; pointing to a good result
